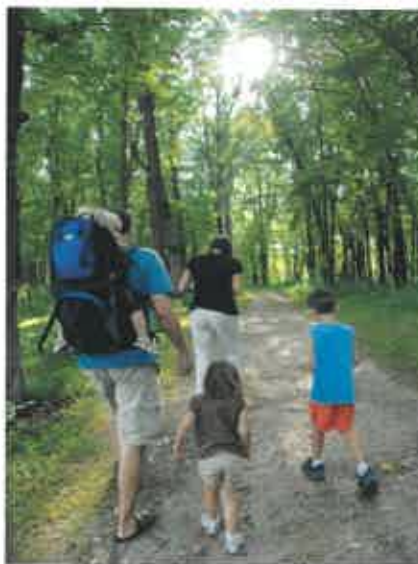
Entertainment and Attractions

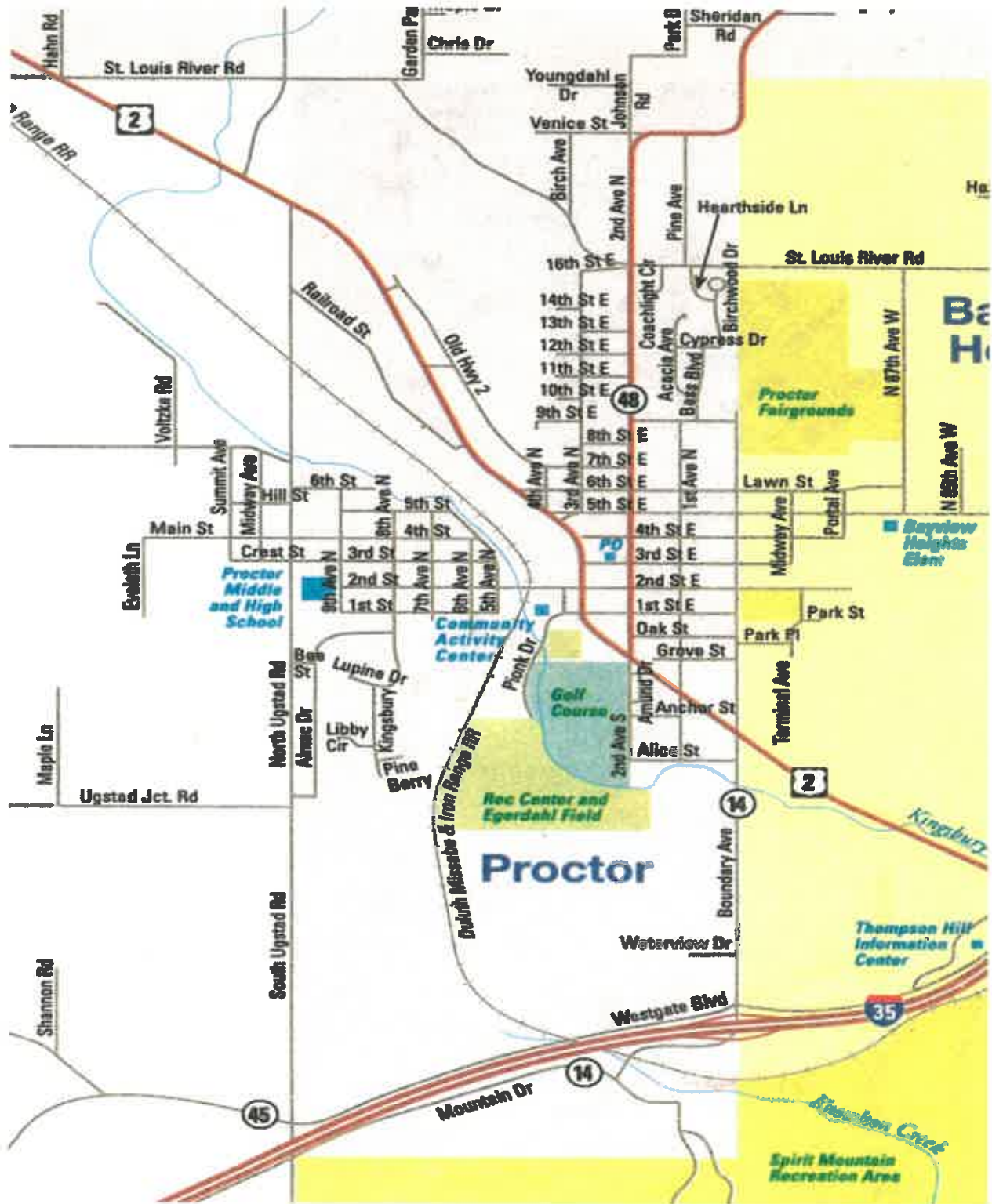
